INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT IN BUDAUN

4437. SHRI ADITYA YADAV:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has made any assessment regarding industrial development in Budaun district of Uttar Pradesh including the number of registered Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) units, employment generated, region-wise distribution of enterprises and trends, if any, indicating decline in growth rate in official data;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the steps taken by the Government to remove stagnation in the growth of the MSME sector, ensure availability of institutional credit, promote technological upgradation and strengthen institutional coordination through District Industries Centres and MSME Development Institutions; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a): The Government has not conducted a specific industrial development assessment in the Budaun district of Uttar Pradesh. However, Udyam Portal data shows an increasing industrial trend in the MSME sector, with 79,527 MSMEs registered as of March 15, 2026, employing 7,70,486 persons.

Furthermore, a comparative analysis of data from April 1, 2023, and February 28, 2026, as in the table given below, indicates a strong upward trend in new MSME registrations on Udyam Portal. This indicates steady growth in the MSME sector compared to figures recorded on April 1, 2023.
