be pleased to state:

(a) the number of black spots identified by the Government on the Barmer section of the Amritsar-Jamnagar Expressway to prevent accidents and the budget allocated to evolve a permanent resolution in this regard;

(b) whether the Government proposes to indicate the timeline for establishment of the proposed Multi Modal Logistics Park (MMLP) and industrial corridor along this expressway with the objective of providing employment opportunities to the local youth of Barmer; and

(c) whether any proposal exists to ensure installation of high quality fencing along the entire section of the expressway to prevent accidents caused by stray animals and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) Road Safety Audit of the Amritsar-Jamnagar Access Controlled Highway in the State of Rajasthan has been conducted in accordance with the codal provisions of the Indian Road Congress (IRC). As per the findings of the audit study, no black spots have been identified on the said stretch.

(b) For development of Multi Modal Logistics Park (MMLP), land is to be provided by the concerned State Government. No such proposal has been received from Government of Rajasthan offering land for development of MMLP.

(c) The boundary wall has already been constructed along the entire Access controlled Amritsar-Jamnagar Corridor.
