INCLUSION OF PROJECTS IN SECOND PHASE OF 'NAMAMI GANGE PROGRAMME'

Will the Minister of **JAL SHAKTI** be pleased to state:

(a) whether any specific projects have been included in the second phase of the 'Namami Gange Programme' for pollution control of the major tributaries of the Ganga such as the Sone, the Gandak and the Kosi rivers in Bihar; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b) Under Namami Gange Programme, a total of 6 Sewage Infrastructure projects have been sanctioned in Bihar on the major tributaries of the river Ganga, namely the Sone, Gandak, and Koshi rivers, at an estimated cost of ₹618 crores. These projects aim to reduce the pollution load in the River Ganga, with a total treatment capacity of 78 MLD.
