DILAPIDATED CONDITIONS OF ROAD

†4596. SHRI RAM SHIROMANI VERMA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is aware that the extremely important road in Shravasti Lok Sabha Constituency, namely the Utraula–Pachpedwa–Chandanpur road, of which approximately 55 kilometers stretches from Ganwariya, Ratanpur Chauraha, Pachpedwa, Imilia Koder, Kohargaddi up to the Chandanpur Border Security Force (BSF) outpost, is presently in a highly dilapidated condition and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether it is a fact that due to deep potholes at several locations, inadequate width and damaged stretches on the said road, there exists a serious risk of accidents and movement becomes almost impossible during the monsoon season and if so, the details thereof; and

(c) whether the Government is considering granting approval to a time-bound project for widening, strengthening or reconstruction of the said road and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c) The Government in Ministry of Road Transport and Highways is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs).

The stretch from Utraula to Pachpedwa to Chandanpur road is a Major District Road (MDR) under the jurisdiction of State Government of Uttar Pradesh.
