TRADE WITH RUSSIA

469. DR. MOHAMMAD JAWED:

Will the Minister of **COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** (वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्री) be pleased to state:

- (a) the details regarding the present trade with Russia;
- (b) whether the threats of USA over tariff rate impacted the trade between the countries;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the manner in which this impact influences the Indian economy;
- (d) the details of trade between India and Russia during the last five calendar year in terms of volume and value; and
- (e) the details of the top five trading commodities between the two countries during the same period in terms of volume and value?

(a) Bilateral trade between India and Russia in calendar year 2025 stood at USD 63.6 billion, comprising Indian exports of USD 4.4 billion and imports of USD 59.1 billion.

(b) & (c) India's trade decisions are guided by overall national economic interests and prevailing conditions in global markets. Commercial entities make procurement choices based on factors such as price competitiveness, supply availability, and market dynamics. No impact on bilateral trade between India and Russia based on policies of third countries has been observed.

(d) & (e) Country-wise and commodity-wise trade statistics, including quantity (volume) and value, are compiled by the Directorate General of Commercial Intelligence and Statistics (DGCI&S) and are available in public domain on the Department of Commerce Trade Statistics Portal.
