Strengthening AYUSH Healthcare Infrastructure

4793. Shri Dharambir Singh:

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the AYUSH hospitals, dispensaries and wellness centres functioning in Bhiwani and Mahendragarh districts of Haryana, stream-wise;
- (b) whether there is any shortage of AYUSH doctors, pharmacists or paramedical staff in the Constituencies and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to upgrade existing AYUSH dispensaries into integrated AYUSH hospitals in South Haryana and, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the AYUSH services are being effectively integrated with primary healthcare under Ayushman Bharat; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to expand preventive healthcare, yoga training and traditional medicine awareness in rural and semi-arid areas of the Constituency?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH

(SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) As reported by State of Haryana, the stream-wise details of the Ayush Hospitals, Dispensaries and Ayushman Arogya Mandir (AAM) (Ayush) in Bhiwani and Mahendragarh districts is placed at **Annexure**.

(b) & (c) Public Health being a State subject, availability/shortage of Ayush doctors, Pharmacists or Paramedical staff in Bhiwani and Mahendragarh Districts of Haryana is maintained by the State Government. However, as reported by State Government, adequate Ayush doctors, Pharmacists or Paramedical staff are working in these constituencies. Further, upgradation of Ayush Dispensaries in South Haryana also comes under the purview of respective State Government. However, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National

Ayush Mission (NAM), State Government may avail financial assistance for upgradation of facilities by submitting suitable proposals through their State Annual Action Plans (SAAP) as per the provisions of NAM guideline. As reported by the State of Haryana, no proposal for upgrading existing Ayush dispensaries into Integrated Ayush Hospitals in South Haryana has been submitted under the SAAP.

(d) Government of India has adopted a strategy of Co-location of Ayush facilities at Primary Health Centres (PHCs), Community Health Centres (CHCs) and District Hospitals (DHs), thus enabling choice to the patients for different systems of medicines under single window. The engagement of Ayush Doctors/paramedics and their training is supported by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) under National Health Mission (NHM), while the support for Ayush infrastructure, equipment /furniture and medicines is provided by Ministry of Ayush under NAM as shared responsibilities.

(e) As reported by State Government of Haryana, the preventive healthcare yoga activities are being provided to the general public in Haryana including rural and semi-arid areas of Bhiwani and Mahendergarh Constituencies through 112 Ayush Yog Sahayaks in 112 Vayamshalas and Yoga Instructors posted in AAM (Ayush). Further, IEC activities such as Ayush awareness Camps are also organised twice in a month through all AAM (Ayush) and during the occasion of National Ayurveda Day, National Homoeopathic Day, Basant Panchami, National Naturopathy Day and Poshan Maah in Bhiwani and Mahendergarh Constituencies.
