Construction of Toilets in Schools

†4849. Shri Brijendra Singh Ola:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has achieved the target of constructing at least one toilet in every primary, upper primary and secondary level school in the country;
- (b) if so, the details of the total number of toilets constructed so far along with the number of schools covered thereunder, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the number of schools in Rajasthan that do not have functional toilets and the total number of toilets in Government schools in Rajasthan as on 31 January, 2026, district-wise; and
- (d) the total number of toilets constructed and the number of toilets repaired in Rajasthan during the last three years including the number of toilets presently functional, year-wise and district-wise?

(a) & (b): Education is in the concurrent list of the Constitution and majority of the schools are under the domain of respective State and UT Governments. Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Samagra Shiksha, States and UTs are supported for strengthening of existing government schools and for creation and augmentation of infrastructure facilities, including construction of **toilets**, based on the gaps determined from Unified District Information System for Education (UDISE) database and proposals received from respective State/UT. The requirement of infrastructural facilities in schools, including toilets are worked out every year by the respective State/Union Territory depending on their need and priority and reflected in their Annual Work Plan and Budget (AWP&B). These plans are then appraised and approved by Project Approval Board (PAB) in consultation with the States and UTs as per the programmatic and financial norms of the scheme.

As per mandate of NEP-2020, the Government of India is taking targeted and saturation approach in providing basic infrastructure facilities including toilets. State-wise number of toilets in primary, upper primary and secondary school in the country is attached at **Annexure-I**.
