**PM INTERNSHIP SCHEME IN MADHYA PRADESH
QUESTION**

4897. Smt. Anita Nagarsingh Chouhan:

Will the Minister of CORPORATE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing the Prime Minister's Internship Scheme (PMIS) to provide the youth of the country with practical experience in industry and employment-oriented skills;**
- (b) if so, its current status in Madhya Pradesh;**
- (c) the total number of internships schemes in Madhya Pradesh and the district-wise details of the number of youths provided internship opportunities so far, particularly in Ratlam-Jhabua-Alirajpur Parliamentary Constituency;**
- (d) whether facilities such as stipend, training and insurance are being provided during the internship period under the scheme, if so, the details thereof; and**
- (e) whether any special awareness campaign or skill upgradation programme has been conducted to increase the participation of youth in the said parliamentary constituency and if so, the details thereof?**

(a) & (b): As an initiation to the Prime Minister Internship Scheme, Ministry of Corporate Affairs has launched a Pilot Project of the Scheme on 3rd October, 2024 to provide internship opportunities to the youth across the country, including Madhya Pradesh. The Ministry has implemented two rounds of the Pilot Project as on date and is in process of implementing the Round III of the Pilot Project

regarding which the revised guidelines have been issued vide OM dated 12.03.2026.

(c): The district-wise details of the internship offers made by partner companies to the youth in Madhya Pradesh for both Round I and Round II is placed at Annexure. The parliamentary constituency-wise data of the same is not maintained.

(d): The Prime Minister Internship Scheme (PMIS) Pilot Project provides an opportunity to the youth to get training and gain experience and skills within the real-life environment of various businesses or organizations with the intention of enhancing their employability by bridging the gap between academic learning and industry requirements.

Under the Pilot Project of PMIS, monthly assistance is being paid to the interns which has been enhanced from Rs. 5000 to Rs. 9000 with effect from March 2026. In addition, a one-time grant of Rs. 6,000/- is paid for incidentals. Further, each intern is being provided with the Life and Personal Accidental Insurance for which premium amount is being provided by the Government.

(e): The Ministry has taken various measures to expand participation of youth in the scheme by actively collaborating with state governments, educational institutions and industries association for implementation and promotion of the scheme. Education and Communication activities, including workshops, seminars, and promotional campaigns - both online and on-ground were carried out to amplify program visibility and to reach out to the target groups in various. These campaigns are being carried out for whole of the country including various districts of Madhya Pradesh.
