5114. Shri Rajeev Rai:

Will the Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying

- (a) the number of beneficiaries under the National Livestock Mission and other major livestock development schemes during 2024-25 in Uttar Pradesh including Mau district and Ghosi Lok Sabha Constituencies;
- (b) the details of breed improvement and livestock vaccination programmes implemented in the district and the coverage achieved;
- (c) whether any project under dairy infrastructure schemes, including the Dairy Infrastructure Development Fund, are being implemented in Mau district; if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether any review has identified challenges such as fodder shortages or disease outbreaks affecting livestock in the district; and
- (e) the measures taken by the Government to strengthen animal health services, veterinary infrastructure and farmer training in Ghosi constituency?

(a) As per the State Government, the number of beneficiaries under the Scheme National Livestock Mission in Uttar Pradesh during 2024-26 is 112. The Ghosi Lok Sabha Constituency comprises of Madhuban, Ghosi, Muhammadabd-Gohna and Mau assembly of Mau District and Rasara assembly of Ballia District. The number of beneficiaries under the Scheme National Livestock Mission in district Mau and Ghosi Lok Sabha Constituency during 2024-26 is one. The number of beneficiaries under Risk Management & Livestock Insurance scheme of National Livestock Mission are given below:-

(c) There is no project under Dairy Infrastructure schemes in Mau district.

(d) and (e). As per the State Government, the State has identified the fodder shortages challenges in the State of Uttar Pradesh to overcome the shortages. The Government has been implementing the following fodder development schemes in the FY 2025-26:-

(i) The Uttar Pradesh Government is implementing a state scheme for all districts of UP designated as "Additional Fodder Development Programme (AFDP)", in which Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of Uttar Pradesh is distributing free of cost certified fodder seed minikit among farmers for promoting quality green fodder cultivation viz. Barseem, Sorghum etc. The number of fodder seed minikit distributed during 2024-25 and 2025-26 is 51151 and 41563 respectively.

(ii) The State is implementing UP Fodder policy (2024-29) for increasing fodder availability and area under fodder coverage. In this policy, farmers are being provided free of cost fodder seeds and Hybrid Napier root slips also Napier root slip propagation and Napier green fodder production scheme are implemented.

To strengthen the animal husbandry sector in Ghosi Lok Sabha Constituency (District Mau), the Government has implemented the following measures:

- Continuous upgradation, by reconstructing new buildings for veterinary hospitals and livestock centers whose buildings were dilapidated.
- Mobile Veterinary Units (MVUs): 4 Mobile Veterinary Units are deployed to provide specialized veterinary emergency services to animal owners at their door steps in remote areas in Ghosi constituency.
- Vaccination Drives: Saturation level vaccination drives under NADCP (National Animal Disease Control Programme) are carried out to eradicate FMD (Foot and Mouth Disease) and Brucellosis disease.
- Health Camps organization: 'Pashu Arogya Camps' and Regular animal health camps within the constituency are organized for free health check-ups and medicine distributions.
- Under the Training & Extension programme, the livestock farmers are trained on various Animal Husbandry activities.
