AROMA REVOLUTION POLICY

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government of Uttarakhand has taken an initiative to promote traditional and aromatic farming through the "Aroma Revolution Policy 2026-36";
- (b) if so, the details of the financial and technical assistance provided by the Union Government to the State so far under this policy;
- (c) the Central schemes being implemented for marketing, processing and value addition of traditional crops in the hilly areas; and
- (d) the future action plan to increase the income of small and marginal farmers of Uttarakhand?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

- (a): As per information furnished by Government of Uttarakhand, the Government of Uttarakhand has approved the Uttarakhand Mahak Kranti Niti (2026–36) on 23 September 2025 to promote aromatic farming.
- (b): Mahak Kranti Niti is state sponsored Scheme, therefore, no financial and technical assistance has been provided by the Union Government to the State Government.
- (c): The following schemes are implemented by Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare for marketing, processing and value addition of traditional crops in the hilly areas-

1. Agriculture Infrastructure Fund (AIF)
2. Formation and Promotion of 10,000 new Farmer Producers Organizations (FPOs)
