IMPLEMENTATION OF PM VIKAS SCHEME

5432. DR. MOHAMMAD JAWED:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of beneficiaries targeted and trained under the Skilling (Traditional and Non-Traditional) component of the Pradhan Mantri Virasat Ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS) scheme, State-wise;
- (b) the details of the number of women beneficiaries targeted and trained under the Leadership & Entrepreneurship (including Biz Sakhis) component of the scheme, State-wise;
- (c) the details of the number of beneficiaries enrolled in the Education Support (NIOS/bridge programmes) component of the scheme, State-wise; and
- (d) whether the Government maintains data on the employment outcomes of beneficiaries trained under PM VIKAS and if so, the details thereof, component-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS

(SHRI KIREN RIJJU)

(a): The Ministry of Minority Affairs implements Pradhan Mantri Virasat Ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS) Scheme as a Central Sector scheme which converges five erstwhile schemes viz. 'Seekho Aur Kamao', 'Nai Manzil', 'Nai Roshni' 'USTTAD' and 'Hamari Dharohar'; and focuses on socio-economic empowerment of six notified minorities through skill development; entrepreneurship and leadership development of minority women; and education support for school dropouts. The scheme was launched in January 2025 and the training has commenced only during the ongoing financial year. Under the scheme, a total target of over 1.47 lakh candidates has been allocated to Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs), as on date, a state-wise allocation of targets (as on date), is placed at **Annexure**.

(b): Under the Women Leadership and Entrepreneurship component of the PM VIKAS Scheme, target has been allocated to train 3,380 candidates, out of which training has been completed for 120 candidates. State-wise bifurcation of target allocation and number of trained candidates as on date is placed at **Annexure**.

(c): Under the Education component of the PM VIKAS Scheme, target has been allocated to enrol 22,000 candidates. State-wise bifurcation of allocation as on date is placed at **Annexure**.

(d): Since the implementation of projects has commenced only during the ongoing financial year, impact assessment is envisaged to be initiated after completion of training activities.
