MISSION SHAKTI IMPLEMENTATION

5620. SHRI B Y RAGHAVENDRA:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing the umbrella scheme Mission Shakti for ensuring safety, protection and empowerment of women in the country, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of facilities such as One Stop Centre Scheme and Women Helpline Scheme established under the said scheme since its inception, State-wise including Karnataka, district-wise;
- (c) the number of women who have availed services under these facilities in the said State during the last five years; and
- (d) the details of the funds allocated, released/utilised under Mission Shakti in the said State during the said period?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT
(SHRIMATI SAVITRI THAKUR)

(a) to (c): The Government gives utmost priority to the safety, security, health, education, nutrition, rehabilitation and empowerment of women and children and has adopted multi-pronged approach to address their educational, social and economic empowerment across the country.

Mission Shakti aims at strengthening interventions for women safety, security and empowerment. Mission Shakti comprises of two verticals 'sambal' for safety and security of women and 'Samarthya' for empowerment of women across the country including the state of Karnataka.

One Stop Centre (OSC) is a component of the Sambal vertical under the umbrella Mission Shakti. It provides integrated and immediate support and assistance under one roof to women affected by violence and those in distress, both in private and public spaces. It provides **services** like medical aid, legal aid and advice, temporary shelter, police assistance and psycho-social counselling to needy women. As on date, 926 One Stop Centres have been

made operational across the country and since inception, i.e. 1st April, 2015 to 31st December, 2025, over 13.37 lakh women have been assisted in the country. As on date, 42 OSCs are operational in the State of Karnataka and over 38 thousand women have been assisted through these OSCs in the State. The details of State and UT-wise operational One Stop Centres (OSCs) across the country are at **Annexure-I** and the district-wise operational OSCs in the State of Karnataka are at **Annexure-II**.

Women Helpline (181) provides 24-hour toll-free telecommunication services to support women in both emergency and non-emergency situations. Since inception till 28th February, 2026, over 99.09 lakh women have been assisted in the country, out of which over 96 thousand women have been assisted in the State of Karnataka through Women Helpline. State Government of West Bengal is not implementing Women Helpline.

(d) Mission Shakti is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme and funds are being released on the basis of guidelines of Department of Expenditure, prescribed for Single Nodal agency (SNA) or SNA SPARSH of the Public Financial Management System (PFMS). Fund released/expenditure under Mission Shakti for the State of Karnataka for 2021-22 is 155.38 Crore, for 2022-23 is 158.50 Crore, for 2023-24 is 144.84 Crore, for 2024-25 is 174.92 Crore, and for 2025-26 is 65.18 Crore.
