Monitoring of CSR funds

QUESTION

†5789. Shri Rajkumar Roat:

Will the Minister of CORPORATE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is fact that companies are spending thousands of crores of rupees on social development under the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Act, if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) the details of total CSR funds collected and spent during the years 2020 to 2025, year-wise and State-wise;**
- (c) the details of the above mentioned CSR funds spent in scheduled districts of Rajasthan, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra during the last ten years, State-wise and district-wise;**
- (d) whether the Government proposes to launch a separate tracking portal, social audit and involving Gram Sabha/local bodies to monitor CSR Funds and implement monitoring system;**
- (e) if so, the time by which it is likely to be implemented; and**
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?**

ANSWER

- (a): On the basis of annual filings made by the companies in the MCA21 registry, Development sector wise CSR expenditure in India during the Financial Years 2019-20 to 2023-24 is at Annexure-I.**
- (b): Under the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act'), CSR is a Board driven process and the Board of the company is empowered to plan, decide, execute and monitor CSR activities of the company undertaken in the areas or subjects specified in Schedule VII of the Act, based on the recommendation of its CSR committee. There are no provisions in the CSR legal framework for collection and expenditure of CSR funds by the Government.**
State wise CSR expenditure in India by the companies during the Financial Years 2019-20 to 2023-24 is at Annexure-II. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs had allowed all companies to complete their annual filings including that of CSR expenditure pertaining to FY 2024-25 till 31st January, 2026 without payment of additional fees. Companies are still in process of filing for FY 2024-25.
- (c): District wise CSR expenditure in Rajasthan, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra during the Financial Years 2014-15 to 2023-24 is at Annexure-III, IV, V & VI respectively.**
- (d) to (f): There is no such proposal. All data related to CSR expenditure filed by companies in MCA21 registry including State-wise, District-wise, year-wise, Development Sector-wise, project-wise and company-wise, are available in public domain and can be accessed at www.csr.gov.in. Under the Act, CSR is a Board driven process and the Board of the company is empowered to plan, decide, execute and monitor CSR activities of the company based on the recommendation of its CSR**

Committee. The Board of the company is required to disclose the CSR Policy implemented by the company in its Board report. The Board of the company has to satisfy itself that the funds so disbursed have been utilised for the purposes and in the manner as approved by it, and the Chief Financial Officer or the person responsible for financial management shall certify to the effect.

Rule 8 of the Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014 provides that every company having average CSR obligation of 10 crore rupees or more in the three immediately preceding financial years, shall undertake impact assessment, through an independent agency, of their CSR projects having outlays of one crore rupees or more, and which have been completed not less than one year before undertaking the impact study. The details of CSR activities, Impact Assessment, etc., are required to be reported by all the companies in the 'Annual Report on CSR' including annual action plan on CSR which is part of the Company's Board Report. The existing legal provisions regarding formation of CSR committee, formulation of CSR policy, Annual Action Plan on CSR, identification of the project and area in which project will be implemented, certification of CSR expenditure by Chief Financial Officer (CFO) and audit of CSR expenditure by statutory auditors, etc., provide adequate mechanisms to ensure transparency and accountability.
