**(a): As an initiation to the Prime Minister Internship Scheme (PMIS), which was announced in the Budget 2024-25, Ministry of Corporate Affairs has launched a Pilot Project on 3rd October, 2024. Two rounds of the Pilot Project have been completed and Round III of the Pilot Project has started on 20.03.2026 with revised guidelines.**

**(b) and (c): Details of amount sanctioned and utilized for the Prime Minister Internship Scheme since inception is placed at Annexure.**

**(d): As on 15.03.2026, over 16,060 interns joined their internship under Round I & Round II of PMIS Pilot Project.**
