Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the data on the seizure of narcotic substances such as heroin, ganja, cocaine and synthetic drugs since 2020 along with the data on the drug trafficking networks or modules have been busted through joint operations by NCB, year and State-wise;**
- (b) the data on the funds have been allocated, sanctioned, disbursed and expended for narcotics control and drug demand reduction programmes over the last five years, year and State-wise;**
- (c) the details of the steps that have been taken by the Government to curb narcotics trafficking and drug smuggling, especially across international borders and coastal areas;**
- (d) the details of the steps that have been taken by the Government to use satellite imaging, drone surveillance and high-tech sensors for detecting cross-border drug trafficking routes; and**
- (e) whether the Government is considering to strengthen international cooperation with neighbouring countries and global agencies, if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS
(SHRI NITYANAND RAI)**

(a): The year and State-wise details of narcotic substances seized during the year 2020 to 2025 (up to November) as reported by various Drug Law Enforcement Agencies (DLEAs) to Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) is at Annexure-I. NCB regularly conducts joint operations with State and Central Drug Law Enforcement Agencies to ensure coordinated action against drug trafficking syndicates, however, separate consolidated data on drug trafficking networks or modules busted through joint operations, year-wise and State-wise, is not maintained by NCB.

(b): The year-wise budget allocation and State-wise details of financial assistance provided to States/ UTs under the scheme 'Assistance to States/ UTs for Narcotic Control' during 2021-22 to 2025-26 is at Annexure-II.

In addition, Government of India through the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJ&E) is implementing National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR) under which financial assistance is provided to- (i) 'State Governments/ Union Territory (UT) Administrations for Preventive Education and Awareness Generation, Capacity Building, Skill development, vocational training and livelihood support of ex-drug addicts, Programmes for Drug Demand Reduction by States/UTs etc. and

(ii) 'NGOs/VOs for running and maintenance of Integrated Rehabilitation Centres for Addicts (IRCAs), Community based peer Led Intervention (CPLI) for early Drug Use Prevention among Adolescents and Outreach and Drop In Centres (ODIC) Addiction treatment facilities (ATFs) in Government Hospitals' and District De-addiction Centres (DDACs) in the identified districts. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoH&FW) provides treatment (OPD and IPD) and counseling services to substance use disorder through 06 Drug Addiction Treatment Centres (DATCs) and provides treatment (OPD) and Counselling services at district level through 25 Drug Treatment Clinics (DTCs) established in Government Hospitals. For implementing this programme the funds allocated and released/ disbursed during the last five years are as under: -

Government of India through Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance has constituted National Fund for Control of Drug Abuse (NFCDA) under which funds are provided to eligible applicant for combating illicit trafficking in narcotics drugs, psychotropic substances, controlling the abuse of narcotic drugs, de-addiction and rehabilitation of addicts and drug awareness programs etc. The details of funds sanctioned under NFCDA during the last five financial years are as under: -

(c) to (e): Government has taken various measures to curb narcotics trafficking and drug smuggling especially across international borders and coastal areas, use of technologies for detecting drug trafficking in the border areas and to strengthen international cooperation with neighbouring countries and global agencies, some of which are as under:

-

(i) Director General Level Talks are being organized with countries such as Myanmar, Nepal, Thailand, Sri Lanka, Indonesia, Singapore, USA etc. to resolve various issues on drug trafficking having international implications.

(ii) Border Guarding Forces (BSF, Assam Rifles and SSB) have been empowered under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act 1985 to carry out search, seizure and arrest for illicit trafficking of narcotic drugs at international border.

- (iii) The Indian Coast Guard has been empowered under the Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 for making interdiction of narcotic drugs in coastal and high seas.**
- (iv) Narcotics Control Bureau coordinates with other agencies like, Navy, Coast Guard, Border Security Force, State ANTF etc. to conduct joint operations to control the drug trafficking.**
- (v) Regular inspections are conducted by port authorities to ensure that all goods, including containers, are properly inspected and cleared before it's released.**
- (vi) The Coast Guard is providing training to NCB and Port Authorities for detection and prevention of drug trafficking.**
- (vii) A high-level dedicated group has been created in National Security Council Secretariat (NSCS) to analyze drug trafficking through maritime routes, challenges and solutions (Maritime Security Group – NSCS).**
- (viii) National Security Council Secretariat (NSCS) in coordination with sister agencies has prepared an SOP on Maritime Security Coordination for anti-smuggling operations (including NDPS substances) in Maritime Zones of India.**

- (ix) The installation of upgraded Surveillance grid using AI based features, RADARS, Electro Optics Devices, Night Vision Devices, Motion Detectors with Integrated Command and Control Centre.**
- (x) Institutionalizing drone based capabilities for aerial surveillance/ recce/ search/ domination etc. across the border.**
- (xi) Intelligence Sharing and Controlled Delivery (CD) Operations with foreign countries are being carried out regularly.**
- (xii) Regular efforts are being made to Increase international cooperation for exchange of information and investigative assistance in administering control over the movement of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances and Precursor Chemicals.**
- (xiii) As a part of International co-operation, India has signed Bilateral Agreements with 27 countries, Memorandum of Understandings with 19 countries for combating illicit trafficking of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) and Chemical Precursors as well as related offences.**
- (xiv) India is closely associated with International Narcotics Control Board (INCB) and all its programs viz. PEN (Pre-export notification), PICS (Precursors Incident Communication System) and IONICS (International Operations on New Psychoactive Substances Incident Communication System).**

(xv) Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) co-ordinates with various international organizations such as South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation- Drug Offences Monitoring Desk (SAARC-SDOMD), Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa (BRICS), Colombo Plan, Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN), ASEAN Senior Officials on Drug Matters (ASOD), Bay of Bengal Initiative For Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Co-Operation (BIMSTEC), Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO), United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), International Narcotics Control Board (INCB) etc. for sharing information and intelligence to combat trans-national drug trafficking.

(xvi) NCB India takes part in real-time operational and intelligence information sharing with various Drug Liaison Officers of other countries such as the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) of the United States of America, the National Crime Agency of the United Kingdom, Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) of Canada, Australian Federal Police (AFP) of Australia, Office Anti-Stupefants (OFAST) of France etc.
