PROJECTS PENALISED UNDER PM-SGMBY

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of number of projects that have been de-registered and/or levied penalties under Pradhan Mantri-Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana (PM-SGMBY) during the last five years, State-wise and district-wise for Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) the details of total number of nonperforming/ under-performing system components and their compensation of replacement/repair during the last five years State and district-wise; and
- (c) the details of the registered vendors registered under National Portal in the State of Uttar Pradesh, district-wise?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSG: MBY), launched in February 2024, is a demand-driven scheme wherein all residential consumers in the country having a grid-connected electricity connection of the local DISCOM can avail the benefits of the scheme, for installation of rooftop solar (RTS) systems, by applying on the National Portal of the scheme. Presently, there is no provision for de-registering and/or levying any penalties on the applications received on the National Portal.

Under the PMSG: MBY, registered vendors are required to maintain the RTS plants installed for 5 years from the date of commissioning. Further, the respective OEMs provide warranties on the system components.

The district-wise detail of vendors registered under the PMSG: MBY in the state of Uttar Pradesh is given in **Annexure**.
