ALL INDIA RADIO STATIONS IN MADHYA PRADESH

902. DR. FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE:

Will the Minister of **INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING** be pleased to state:

- a) the number of All India Radio (Akashvani) stations being operated by the Government particularly in the State of Madhya Pradesh;
- b) whether adequate staff is available in the centres operated by the Government and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- c) the details of such centres where sufficient staff is available for the operation of the centres?

(a) to (c) All India Radio (AIR) has 591 broadcasting stations in the country, including 38 stations in Madhya Pradesh. Akashvani carries out human resource management as per its requirements which includes periodic assessment, training and reskilling.
