STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF STARRED QUESTION No. 97 BY SHRI ABHISHEK SINGH AND SHRI J. C. DIVAKAR REDDY TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 27.07.2015 REGARDING SOLAR TRAINS

(a): No, Madam. There is no proposal to introduce Solar power hauled trains. However, for train lighting, 18 Narrow gauge coaches and 2 Broad gauge non air conditioned coaches have been provided with Solar panels on roof top on trial basis. Integral Coach Factory, Chennai has also taken up a project recently in association with Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore for provision of 2 Solar panels in one Broad gauge coach for data collection in different weather conditions. Research Designs & Standards Organisation, Lucknow has been asked to submit techno economic feasibility report for provision of Solar panels on coaches for Train lighting & fans. Further course of action will be decided based on the report.
