SETTING UP OF RAILWAY HOSPITALS

†1007. DR. RAVINDRA KUMAR RAY:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways have taken a note that there is no big hospital of Railways in the State of Jharkhand;**
- (b) if so, whether the Railways propose to construct big hospitals/renovate the existing hospitals of Railways in the State of Jharkhand;**
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and**
- (d) the number of railway hospitals operating in the State of Jharkhand as on date?**

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS

(SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

(a) to (d): No, Madam. There are five Divisional/Sub-Divisional Railway Hospitals in the State of Jharkhand. These are located at Chakradharpur (100 bedded Divisional Railway Hospital), Ranchi (50 bedded Divisional Railway Hospital), Dhanbad (104 bedded Divisional

Railway Hospital), Tata (55 bedded Sub – divisional Railway Hospital) and Patratu (21 bedded Sub-divisional Railway Hospital). A total of 18 Railway Health Units are also operating in the State of Jharkhand.

Up-gradation of Railway Hospitals is an on-going process undertaken on the basis of condition of existing equipments/techniques, technological developments taking place in the medical science and availability of funds.
