DIFFERENT RUSSIAN FUEL

1488. SHRI PRALHAD JOSHI:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) the difference in the fuel proposed by Russia to be supplied to the 3rd and 4th nuclear plants of Kudankulam from the one that powered the first and second units;
- (b) whether the new type of fuel is licenced to be supplied in India and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any other countries are using this new type of fuel; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER
