1699. SHRI ARJUN MEGHWAL:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to link States under the Deen Dayal Upadhyay Grameen Kaushalya Yojana;
- (b) if so, the manner in which the States could be linked with the scheme along with the details thereof;
- (c) whether any annual training target has been set under the above scheme;
- (d) if so, the complete details thereof along with the advantages thereof; and
- (e) the details regarding intended beneficiaries who have been gainfully employed under the scheme?

ANSWER

(SHRI BIRENDER SINGH)

(a): Yes, Madam.

(b): The strategy for DDU-GKY is to move from direct implementation to further build capacities of State Governments for implementation of the programme. The Government is assisting the State Governments to prepare Action Plans for Skill development within which a State shall sanction and manage Skill development projects. As per available information, 12 States have achieved status of Action Plan state.

(c) and (d): DDU-GKY has a target of skilling 177986 candidates in the financial year 2015-16. DDU-GKY provides for placement of 75% candidates, who have been skilled under DDU-

GKY program, in jobs with regular wages. This enables a rural poor youth an opportunity to come out of poverty.

(e): State-wise number of candidates given placement in the 12th Five year plan period (till 31st March 2015) is given below:
