Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has announced the Prime Minister Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY-II) in the current year budget;
- (b) if so, the details and the objectives of the scheme; and
- (c) whether the Scheme has been approved by the Government?

ANSWER MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BIRENDER SINGH)

The Government had launched PradhanMantri Gram SadakYojana-II (PMGSY-II) in May, 2013 which aims to consolidate the existing rural roads network and envisages upgradation of existing selected rural roads in all States/Union Territories at an estimated cost of Rs.33,030 Cr. (at 2012-13 prices). The total road length allocated for upgradation under PMGSY-II is 50,000 km during the 12th Five Year Plan period(2012-2017). The funding pattern between the Centre and the States is 75:25 for the plain areas and 90:10 basis for the special areas. The proposals under PMGSY-II received in the Ministry are considered by the Inter Ministerial Empowered Committee, constituted by the Ministry of Rural Development and the their compliance required to communicate Governments are observations/recommendations of the Empowered Committee to the Ministry. The proposals of the State Government which meet the programme requirements are cleared with the approval of the Competent Authority. At present, 7 States (Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh) have been sanctioned road works under PMGSY-II covering 11,234 Km road length.
