DOUBLING OF RAIL LINES

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be please to state:

- (a) the present status of doubling of the Jammu to Jalandhar rail line project;**
- (b) whether the Railways have fixed any time limit to complete the said project; and**
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Railways in this regard?**

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS
(SHRI MANOJ SINHA)**

(a) to (c): Doubling of Jammu-Jalandhar railway line (211 km) was sanctioned in phases. Doubling in the entire length except 23 km involving six major bridges has been completed and commissioned. Work on balance portion is also in full swing. To complete the remaining doubling works, total outlay of ₹ 190 Crores has been provided in the current year which is considered sufficient.
