- (a) whether the Railways have any plan to appoint people as gate counsellors or gate mitras at unmanned railway crossings in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the process of their recruitment and requisite educational qualification etc;
- (c) whether any rules have been formulated for their appointment; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and status of progress made in this regard?

(a) to (d): Gate Counsellors or Gate Mitras are being deployed as a purely temporary measure on experimental basis at identified vulnerable unmanned level crossings till these gates are eliminated.

There is no plan to appoint Gate Mitras on permanent basis.
