Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION नागर विमानन मंत्री

be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government has withdrawn or proposes to withdraw some domestic and international routes of Air India where it is suffering losses;
- (b) if so, the details of such domestic and international routes of Air India, sector-wise;
- (c) whether these routes have been allocated or are proposed to be allocated to the private airlines;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, airline-wise along with the losses incurred/likely to be incurred by Air India as a result thereof; and
- (e) the corrective measures taken/ proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard?

## **ANSWER**
