However, it is learnt that the Ministry of Finance has accorded in-principle approval on 3.2.2015 for viability gap funding to the proposal of Government of Kerala to develop a non-major Port at Vizhinjam on Design Build Finance Operate and Transfer (DBFOT) basis to handle upto 18000 TEU container ships with a rated annual capacity of the Port of 10 lakhs TEUs and the total project cost Rs. 3930 crores.
