SHORTAGE OF CABIN CREW

- (a) whether there is a shortage of cabin crew in Air India due to which flight schedules are getting affected;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to meet the shortage of cabin crew in Air India?

ANSWER

- (a) : Despite the shortage of cabin crew, the flights have been dispatched on time most of the times. At times the flights have been rescheduled till crews are made available with advance information to passengers so that they are not inconvenienced.
- (b) & (c): Air India has initiated process for filling up of 800 posts of Cabin Crew. Two exercises have been undertaken and a total of 534 candidates have been selected for appointment as Cabin Crew.
