- (c) whether the said Committee has contemplated on regional and geographical components in comparison to administrative and operational components for ensuring uniform development expansion of Railways across the country;**
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and**
- (e) the steps taken by the Railways to give importance to regional geographical components while taking decision on the restructuring of the railway zones?**
