- 1) Expert Group headed by Shri Sam Pitroda for Modernization of Railways.**
- 2) High Level Safety Review Committee headed by Dr. Anil Kakodkar, former Chairman, Atomic Energy Commission.**
- 3) Committee headed by Shri Sam Pitroda on the usage of Information & Communication Technologies (ICT) in the Railways.**
- 4) High Level Committee headed by Shri D.K. Mittal, IAS (Retired)for improving the financial health of Indian Railways.**
- 5) A Committee headed by Dr. Bibek Debroy, for mobilization of resources for major Railway Projects and restructuring of Railway Ministry and Railway Board.**
- 6) A High Power Committee headed by Shri D. P. Tripathi to review the duty hours of running staff constituted in 2011.**

- 7) One-man Committee of Dr. E. Sreedharan, to suggest a proper system and procedures to ensure proper accountability and transparency in commercial decisions and tendering.**
- 8) Expert Committee headed by Dr. E. Sreedharan to examine the comparative merits of two systems of alignments of Katra-Banihal Section of Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla Rail Link Project.**

As a system, recommendations of Committees are deliberated for acceptance/implementation in the Ministry of Railways and recommendations found implementable are implemented within available resources.
