## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) The total throw forward of funds at the end of the fiscal required for Rail development projects is approximately ₹ 4.99 lakh crores.

- (d) In addition to funds received through Budget, Railways have taken up mobilization of funds from alternate sources like Market Borrowings, Public Private Partnership and Institutional Financing

by tapping low-cost long-term funds from insurance and pension funds, multi-lateral and bilateral agencies which can be serviced through incremental revenues.
