(a) to (c): Government has laid down Route Dispersal Guidelines (RDGs) with a view to achieve better air transport services of different regions of the country. It is, up to the airlines to provide air services to specific places depending upon the traffic demand and commercial viability. As such, the Scheduled domestic airlines are free to operate anywhere in the country subject to compliance with RDGs issued by the Government. However, in a meeting convened recently to discuss operations of flights to/from cities in Punjab, the airline operator 'Alliance Air' has requested for full viability gap funding for mounting flights to/from cities in Punjab.
