**(a) whether there has been a recent incident wherein an Air India's Bengaluru-Hyderabad flight had a narrow escape as the pilot did a "touch and go" after bouncing on the runway during landing;**

**(b) if so, the details thereof;**

**(c) whether the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has ordered a probe into the incident;**

**(d) if so, the details and the findings thereof along with the action taken by DGCA on the basis of the findings; and**

**(e) the steps taken by DGCA to avoid recurrence of such incidents in future?**

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**(a) & (b) : Air India A-319 aircraft VT-SCL was involved in an occurrence while operating flight AI-513 (Bengaluru-Hyderabad) on 28.06.2015, wherein due to variable winds, the aircraft went around at around 20 feet during which balked landing (touch and go) was carried out.**

**(c) to (e) : Inquiry into the incident is yet to be completed by Directorate General of Civil Aviation.**

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
