NARROW ESCAPE OF AIR INDIA'S FLIGHT

3388. SHRI R. PARTHIPAN
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Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether there has been a recent incident wherein an Air India's Bengaluru-Hyderabad flight had a narrow escape as the pilot did a "touch and go" after bouncing on the runway during landing;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has ordered a probe into the incident;
- (d) if so, the details and the findings thereof along with the action taken by DGCA on the basis of the findings; and
- (e) the steps taken by DGCA to avoid recurrence of such incidents in future?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Air India A-319 aircraft VT-SCL was involved in an occurrence while operating flight AI-513 (Bangaluru-Hyderabad) on 28.06.2015, wherein due to variable winds, the aircraft went around at around 20 feet during which balked landing (touch and go) was carried out.

(c) to (e): Inquiry into the incident is yet to be completed by Directorate General of Civil Aviation.
