PENDING PROJECTS UNDER PMGSY

4071. SHRIMATI JYOTI DHURVE:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the proposal of the first batch of the fourteenth phase / projects under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) in Madhya Pradesh are lying pending for approval;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the time by which these projects / phase is likely to be approved ?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SUDARSHAN BHAGAT)

(a) to (c): Since inception of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) scheme in year 2000, the Ministry has cleared proposals for rural roads and bridges with an estimated cost of Rs. 1,83,714 crore to all the States including the State of Madhya Pradesh. As reported by the States, they have spent Rs. 1,34,229 crore till June, 2015 and works amounting to Rs. 49,485 crore are yet to be completed by the States. Keeping in view the large value of works yet to be completed by the States, the Ministry is not considering any new proposals from the States for sanction at present. The States have been advised to concentrate on completion of old pending works on a priority basis.
