NAGPUR BHOPAL INTERCITY TRAIN

†961. SHRIMATI JYOTI DHURVE:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways are considering to introduce a new Nagpur Bhopal Intercity Express train;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the time by which the said train service is likely to be introduced to facilitate the passengers; and
- (d) the total number and details of Intercity Express trains being run in the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) to (c) At present, Nagpur and Bhopal are very well connected with train services. Besides, 4 pairs of train services have been announced in Railway Budget 2014-15, out of which 16863/16864 Mannargudi-Jodhpur Express (weekly) has already been introduced w.e.f. 09.02.2015, and 22703/22704 Secunderabad-H. Nizamuddin Permium AC Express, 22701/22702 Vijaywada-New Delhi AC Express (Daily), 22125/22126 Nagpur-Amritsar Express (Weekly) are yet to be introduced. However, there is no proposal to introduce an Intercity Express between Nagpur and Bhopal, at present.
- (d) Presently, there is no strict definition of "Intercity Express" on Indian Railways. However, around 150 pairs of train services running across the country may be treated as Intercity Express.
