- (d) Whether alleged malpractices/ irregularities/misutilisation of the funds have been reported in implementation of the irrigation projects; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken thereon?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. *173. TO BE ANSWERED ON 10.12.2015 IN LOK SABHA REGARDING “IRREGULARITIES IN UTILISATION OF FUNDS” ASKED BY SHRI RAM PRASAD SARMAH & SHRI OM BIRLA M.P’s, LOK SABHA:

(a) The details of irrigation projects undertaken/completed along with funds released/utilized during each of the last three years, under Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP), National Projects (NP) and Repair, Renovation & Restoration(RRR) of Water Bodies are given at Annexure - I(AIBP),Annexure – I (NP) and Annexure - I(RRR) respectively.

(b) & (c) Proposals pertaining to various projects/schemes relating to water resources, irrigation, de-siltation, river cleaning, water conservation and management under the schemes namely Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP), National Projects (NP), Flood Management Programme (FMP) and Repair, Renovation & Restoration(RRR) of Water Bodies have been received from various States/UTs including Assam, along with action taken are given at Annexure - II(AIBP),Annexure - II(NP), Annexure - II(FMP), Annexure - II(RRR) and Annexure – II (Ganga Cleaning) respectively.

(d) & (e) Water resources / irrigation projects are being planned, designed and implemented by the State Governments as per their requirement and priority and resources available. Union Government is providing central assistance to the State Govts. under above mentioned schemes for early completion of the projects to harness envisaged benefits as per eligibility criteria and fulfilling the laid down norms / guidelines of the schemes. As per the information available the details of irregularities / misutilisation of funds reported are given at **Annexure – III.**

Annexure-III as mentioned in the Part (d) & (e) of Lok Sabha Starred Question no.-173 due for reply on 10.12.2015

1. A complaint regarding alleged diversion of Central Assistance released to Assam State in respect of Minor Irrigation Schemes funded under AIBP, was received by Secretary, CWC from Xachetan Nagarik Mancha, Guwahati. As Minor Irrigation Schemes under AIBP are dealt with the Ministry, the reply to this complaint as received from Secretary, Irrigation Department, Govt of Assam was given by Ministry to the complainant, a copy of which was also sent by CWC to the complainant.

2. There was a VIP reference from Shri Haribau Jawale, MP, Raver Constituency, Maharashtra alleging irregularities in the implementation of XI Plan RRR Scheme in Maharashtra. The Hon'ble MP earlier during May 2013 alleged about non utilisation of funds allocated to Maharashtra for the XI Plan scheme RRR of water bodies. This letter of Honble MP was forwarded to Government of Maharashtra for comments and clarifications. In response, Government of Maharashtra submitted the physical and financial progress of water bodies (Upto March 2014) which were approved during XI Plan vide their letter dated 17.05.2014.

3. Complaints of some irregularities in execution of Gosikhurd Irrigation Project, Maharashtra were received in the past.

In the year 2009, on the complaint of Ex. MLA, Sh. Suresh Gambhir, Maharashtra State Government appointed two committees, namely, Mendhegiri Committee for defective lining work and Vadnere Committee for procedural issues. The Central Government also suggested for special audit from AG-II Maharashtra on financial and procedural issues in execution of Gosikhurd Project. Vidarbha Irrigation Development Corporation (VIDC) has informed that based on the reports of above three committees, following action has been taken by Govt. of Maharashtra:

- (i) Departmental enquiries initiated against 12 officers for carrying out defective lining work.
- (ii) The consents have been taken from the contractor for carrying out relining of defective patches. The details planning in consultation with contractor have been finalized and relining work is being done at the cost of contractor. Hence, there is no burden on State finance or AIBP (National Project) funds.
- (iii) 14 officers were initiated Departmental enquiries for procedural irregularities as per Vadnere Committee report.
- (iv) Total recovery proposed by special audit has been already recovered from the contractors and no dues are pending now.
- (v) Trainings were conducted to ensure no procedural lapses in future.

Enquiry against State Govt. officials and its logical conclusion is in the domain of State Govt. and no further information in this regard is available in CWC. However, it was later reported that Sh. Suresh Gambhir withdrew his complaint in October 2010.

Further, another MLA, Sh. Suresh Wadettiwar also made complaint of similar nature in the year 2012, based on which then Chairman; CWC, visited the project in March, 2012 and submitted his findings to MoWR, RD & GR. Report broadly elaborated about cracks in lining of Mokhabardi Lift Irrigation Scheme, Right Bank canal (RBC) and relining of Left Bank Canal (LBC) and suggested remedial measures as per IS codes. However, it has been reported that Sh. Suresh Wadettiwar withdrew his complaint in May 2014.
