(a) Yes, Madam. An Assured-off Take agreement has been signed by Ministry of Railways with Sail Rites Bengal Wagon Industry Pvt. Ltd. (SRBWIPL) (A Joint Venture company between Steel Authority of India Ltd.(SAIL) and Rail India Technical and Economic Service (RITES)) for procuring 1200 BOXNHL/BCNHL wagons per annum for a period of ten years.

(b) & (c) Railways will receive 1200 new light weight stainless steel wagons per annum from this factory to cater to increasing traffic requirement. The factory will also be free to produce wagons for other customers beyond the quantity assured to Indian Railways.
