Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) the number of post offices and sub-post offices across the country as on date, State-wise;

(b) the targets set and achieved by the Government for opening of new post offices, sub-post offices during the Eleventh Five year Plan and proposed under Twelfth Five Year Plan, State-wise;

(c) whether the Government has reviewed the expansion of post offices and ongoing pending postal and telecommunication projects in various States;

(d) if so, the details and outcome thereof along with the corrective steps taken by the Government in this regard and the action taken to open the proposed post and sub-post offices expeditiously; and

(e) the details of proposals received for opening and upgradation of post offices including the district level post offices in newly bifurcated States?

STATEMENT TO BE LAID ON THE TABLE OF THE LOK SABHA IN RESPECT OF PARTS (a) TO (e) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.258 FOR 16th DECEMBER, 2015 REGARDING "OPENING AND UPGRADATION OF POST OFFICES".

(a) Postal Circle-wise number of post offices including sub-post offices functional in the country are at **Annexure-I.**

(b) Postal Circle-wise details of targets set and achievements for opening of new Branch Post Offices (BOs) and Sub-Post Offices (SOs) during Eleventh Five Year Plan are at **Annexure-II.** Department of Posts has decided to open 400 new BOs and 412 SOs during 12th Five Year Plan under the Plan Scheme "Rural Business & Access to Postal Network". The targets for opening of post offices Postal Circle-wise during first four years of 12th Five Year Plan are at **Annexure-III.** The Postal Circle-wise opening of remaining 56 BOs and 43 SOs for the financial year 2016-17 has not been decided so far as it will depend on allocation of budget in the annual plan.

(c) & (d) Review of expansion of post offices is an on-going process. On review, if it is found that opening of new post offices are justified in particular areas as per prescribed norms for opening of new post offices, post offices are opened in those areas by relocation & redeployment under Plan Scheme.

As regards telecommunication projects, various schemes are implemented with the financial support from Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) for expansion of telecom services in rural and remote areas, details are at **Annexure-IV.**

(e) The details of proposals received for opening and upgradation of post offices including the district level post offices in newly bifurcated States are at **Annexure-V**.

ANNEXURE-IV

Details of schemes being implemented by the Department of Telecommunications for expansion of telecom services in rural and remote areas

(i) Bharat Net/ National Optical Fibre Network (NOFN) was planned in 2011 to connect all 2,50,000 Gram Panchayats in the country through optical fibre utilizing existing fibers of Public Sector Undertaking viz. Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL), Rail Tel and Power Grid Corporation of India Limited (PGCIL) (and of any desirous private operator) and laying incremental fibre wherever necessary for providing broadband connectivity to all Gram Panchayats. As on 30.11.2015, 1,03,643 km. of duct and 74,994 km of optical fibre cable covering 32,049 Gram Panchayats have been laid.

(iii) On 10.09.2014, the Government approved a proposal to implement a Comprehensive Telecom Development Plan for North-Eastern Region (NER). The project envisages to provide mobile coverage to 8621 identified uncovered villages by installation of about 6673 mobile towers, installation of 321 mobile tower sites along National Highways and strengthening of transmission network in the NER. The estimated cost of implementation is Rs. 5336.18 crore. The Project would be funded from Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF). State-wise details are as under:
