(b) to (e): Works of construction of 40 Road Over Bridges/Road Under Bridges (ROBs/RUBs) on National Highway corridor have already been sanctioned in the Railway Budget on cost-sharing basis. Out of these, 17 ROBs/RUBs have been completed. In addition, Railway portion has also been completed in 8 ROBs/RUBs. State-wise details of these 40 ROBs/RUBs are as under:

For the remaining Level Crossings, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has been signed between Ministry of Railways and Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MORTH) on 10.11.2014. As per MOU, MORTH/National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) will replace all level crossings on NH Corridors by Road Over Bridges (ROBs)/Road Under Bridges(RUBs) in next five years subject to availability of funds.
