- (a): Government of India had started National Solar Mission during the year 2010 to increase use of solar energy in the country. So far 4579 MW capacity of grid connected and 280 MW offgrid solar power plants have been installed in the country.
- (b),(c)&(d): Solar products are already being marketed by e-commerce companies.
