- (a) whether the Government has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between India–Taipei Association (ITA) in Taipei and Taipei Economic and Cultural Centre (TECC) in India;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the manner of cooperation in the field of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises proposed thereunder;
- (c) whether the Government has prepared the draft of such cooperation;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the time by which such draft is likely to be prepared?
