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(a)to(c): Joint military exercise is an ongoing bilateral cooperation activity with friendly foreign countries including the United States, Sri Lanka, China and Russia for the purpose of building mutual trust and confidence and strengthening defence cooperation with the objective of upgrading skills and capabilities of our armed forces and also to get exposure to the best practices and advanced defence technology.

(d)&(e): The last bilateral naval exercise with Sri Lanka, Ex-SLINEX-15, was held at Trincomalee, Sri Lanka during October-November, 2015. No reports of protests have come to notice so far.

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
