- (a) whether the average rural wages have fallen rapidly and if so, the details thereof during the last three years and the current year, year-wise;**
- (b) whether any introspection has been done within the Government to find out the reasons behind this sharp fall;**
- (c) if so, whether the Government proposes to relook at the State-level vulnerability on factors like dependence on agriculture income, indebtedness, irrigation, crop insurance, etc., as more than 50 per cent of Indians depend on farming; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the remedial measures taken by the Government in this regard and if not, the reasons therefor?**
