Literacy Rate

1245. SHRI S.R. VIJAYAKUMAR:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the country is still lagging behind in achieving the target of cent-percent literacy;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the measures taken by the Government to achieve the target of cent-percent literacy rate and the time by which this target is likely to be achieved?

ANSWER MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) & (b) The Census 2011 reported 72.98 percent literacy in the country. The Government has set the target of achieving 80% literacy and reducing the gender gap to 10 percentile points by the end of 12th Five Year Plan.
- (c) The Government have enacted The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and launched Saakshar Bharat, a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, to raise the literacy level, in the age group of 6-14 years and 15 years and above, respectively in the country. Phase-wise targets are kept to achieve the desired literacy rate.
