†1315. SHRI CHHEDI PASWAN:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned funds for the development of tourist places in Rohtas and Kaimur districts of Bihar;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has initiated any development work for the development of the said tourist places;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to expedite the said work in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

(a) and (b): Yes, Madam. Development of tourism infrastructure is primarily the responsibility of the State Governments and Union Territory Administrations. The Ministry of Tourism provides Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for projects that are complete as per existing scheme guidelines while considering availability of funds and submission of Utilization Certificates against the funds released earlier.
