(a) & (b): No, Madam. Five sub-project proposals of North East Connectivity Project have been posed to Government of Japan / JICA for Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) Official Development Assistance (ODA) loan for Rs.4923 Crore. The details of the projects are as follows:
