(a) National Research Centre on Integrated Farming (ICAR-NRCIF) was established in the year 2015 to undertake basic, strategic and adaptive research for productive utilization of flooded and flood-prone areas/wetlands in different agro-ecological zones of India through integrated farming system approach ensuring food, nutritional and livelihood security.

(b) An amount of Rs.200.00 lakhs and Rs.2800.00 lakhs has been allocated for 2015-16 and 2016-17 respectively, totaling Rs.3000.00 lakhs during 12th Five Year Plan for establishment of the institute. The prospective activities of the centre are as follows:-

- To develop and demonstrate location-specific and farmer-centric integrated farming system models.
- To act as repository of information and its dissemination on all aspects of integrated farming system.
- To facilitate and promote coordination and dissemination of the technology for integrated farming system models through network/consortia approach involving ICAR institutes, SAUs and other agencies
- To provide scientific leadership and act as a centre for vocational as well as advanced training to promote the technologies related to integrated farming systems.
- To collaborate with relevant national and international agencies in liaison with the state and central government departments for technology dissemination; and
- To provide need-based consultancy and advisory support in promoting farming system models.
