- (a) & (b) Based on less requirement of coaches with bio-toilets to make the limited number of rail sections human waste discharge free, Rameswaram-Manamadurai, Okha-Kanalus, Jammu-Katra and Porbandar-Wansjallya sections have been identified. Presently, biotoilet fitted coaches are being inducted in trains passing through Rameswaram-Manamadurai and Okha-Kanalus on priority.
