1630. SHRI FEROZE VARUN GANDHI:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of students enrolled under various schemes for skill development and training during each of the last three years and the current year, scheme/State-wise;
- (b) the dropout rates under these schemes, year-wise and State-wise;
- (c) the number of institutes available in public, private and Public Private Partnership (PPP) to address the skill gap in the country, State-wise; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (d) There are over 70 skill development schemes across various sectors implemented by over 20 Central Ministries/Departments to promote skilling of all people including youth, in the Country. Details of people trained under various skill development schemes/programmes of over 20 Central Ministries/Departments for the year 2012-13 to 2015-16 (upto October, 2015) are as under:-

2012-2013	72.51	51.88
2013-2014	73.42	76.37
2014-2015	105.08	76.12
2015-2016	122.00	28.85 (upto October, 2015)

Further, there are 13,105 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) (Govt.- 2,293 and Private- 10,812) operational under the Directorate General of Training (DGT) for skilling in the Country. It has been observed that against the total enrollments made in these ITIs, dropout rate is 13 to 14%.

Besides, there are 266 affiliated training partners of National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) operating 4648 training centers, inclusive of 812 mobile centers across 27 States and 5 Union Territories in 525 districts of the Country.
