Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) The aims/objectives/present status of NETAP programme along with the number of people enrolled under the revamped NETAP programme. State-wise during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (b) The targets set by the Government in appointing apprentices;
- (c) The budget allocated for the programme during the above period; and
- (d) The steps taken by the Government to make this programme a success?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

- (a) & (b) MoU has been signed between the Directorate General of Training, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship and Team Lease Skill University. Team Lease Skill University through NETAP (National Employability Through Apprenticeship Programme) would facilitate for engagement of 5 lac apprentices over a period of 3 years on voluntary basis in the country upto March, 2018.
- (c) No fund has been allocated for the programme
- (d) Government of India would work with NETAP continuously to expand the apprentices' scheme in India in accordance with Apprentices Act, 1961 as amended from time to time.
